



On 14th August 2018, Amra Chitmahalbasi organised one meeting at Bangladeshi erstwhile enclave- Batrigach. From that meeting different issues were raised. Still they are deprived from drinking water, solar shallow and utilities of job cards. 80- 100 people have gathered at the upcoming civic discourse at Cooch Behar on 20th August. Representatives of Masum assured them to complain on their issues at the earliest.

On 15th August 2018, Amra Chitmahalbasi organised two interactive meeting with representatives of MASUM and erstwhile enclave dwellers at Falnapur and bhandardaha in Mathabhanga, Cooch Behar. From these interactions several complaints were raised like they were still deprived from their citizenship, land and all other social security schemes. They assured to come to Cooch Behar on 20th August to express their agonies. Around 400 persons will be gathering on 20th programme from Nolgram Falnapur, Jonga, Bhandardaha and Kokeyabari erstwhile enclaves.

On 16th August 2018, Amra Chitmahalbasi organised two interactive meetings with the erstwhile enclave dwellers of Dhabalsuti 13, 14, Panbari, Chit Kuchlibari and Balapukuri. From the discussions it was clearly observed that those people were still neglected from most of the social security schemes like drinking water, latrine, education etc. Besides they are still neglected from their citizenship rights. At least 100 peoples from the mentioned erstwhile enclaves will be coming to convey their agonies.

On 17th August Amra Chitmahalbasi organised 3 interactive meetings with the erstwhile enclave dwellers of Purba Mashaldanga, Kachua, Uttar Bansjani and Poschim Bakalir Chara. Like previous interactions they also complained regarding non fulfillment of developmental work at respective areas. On 20th August at least 150 erstwhile enclave dwellers will be gathering at Cooch Behar to express their pains.

On 18th August Amra Chitmahalbasi organised one interactive meeting at erstwhile enclave Karola. They conveyed their disappointment regarding solar shallow, land, citizenship etc. They assured to come to Cooch Behar on 20th August to express their discontent.
