

Activity report of District Murshidabad on April 2019



On 26th April 2019, MASUM celebrated the anticipatory bail granting to its Murshidabad District Human Rights Monitor; Mr. Sanjit Mondal by High Court of Calcutta. Here it should be mentioned that Sanjit has been falsely implicated in three NDPS cases by Jalangi and Raninagar police stations

and High Court Calcutta granted anticipatory bail in all three cases. On the mentioned date, Mr. Biplab Mukherjee, Mr. Subhpratim Roy Choudhury, Mr. Ramen Moitra and Mr. Mohor Ali Mondal from MASUM along with torture victims and family members of extra judicially killed persons with Sanjit and his family visited the Block Development Officer of Raninagar II block and submitted a memorandum to his office demanding safety and security measures for the human rights defenders. Later, Sanjit was accompanied by the MASUM team to Raninagar Police Station where he handed over the bail order and made attendance as par the condition of bail. Then a street corner meeting was held at Sekhpara market, where above mentioned activists of MASUM spoke about the judicial harassments of local populace and human rights defenders by local police and illegal implication of NDPS sections.
