

On 21st February 2016 Banglar Manabdhikar Surakhya Mancha (MASUM) observes International Mother Language Day at Teen Beegha corridor in front of martyrs's monument. Hundreds of local villagers erstwhile enclave dwellers, local folk singers, students, lawyers, politician, journalists from Bangladesh assembled and paid their homage.

The program starts with inaugural speech of Mr. Kurity Roy, Secretary of MASUM. Then it was continued with songs from Mr. Bipul Chakraborty , Mrs Anushree Chakraborty, Mr. Dilip Chatterjee from kolkata and some local folk artist from cooch behar. Especially Mr. Abraham linkon , advocate from Bangladesh was also present on that program.

The gathering demanded unanimously that

1. Indo- Bangladesh border became a violent border, people of bordering villages are being continuously harassed , assaulted , coerced by the para military forces of both the countries with impunity, which should be stopped.

2. The erstwhile enclave dwellers of both the countries were denied citizenship of respected country till date, compensation and rehabilitation to the enclave dwellers from Bangladesh settled in three temporary camps running inhuman way. Titles of their own land yet not handed over to the original land owners.

Aforesaid problems should be addressed by the government according to Indian Constitution, guidelines made by the apex court and according to International law.
