



MASUM jointly organised one camp with Cooch Behar District Legal Services Authority DLSA at Dinhata Krishi Mela (Detention camp for the erstwhile Indian Enclave dwellers) brought from Bangladesh by the Government of India on 24 November 2015. Hence from that day those people are under custody of Government.

Two women and two men described their pathos. In nutshell, 3 people (Ms. Puti Barman - 29yrs, Mr. Samsul Haque 39 yrs, and another woman) died allegedly without treatment. There was no doctor / medical examination for last 7 months. There was no supply of clothes, no fuel, no oven, not even match box supplied by govt. HENCE THE PEOPLE HAD TO GO DIFFERENT STATES FOR WANT OF JOB.

100 days' work not maintained. Families have to borne the costs of their children.

Before starting the camp MASUM received one after another phone calls from various offices, SDO Dinhata, DM Enclave Cell, etc. that we can not held this meeting without permission from SDO Dinhata, later changed, permission from DM, Cooch Behar. MASUM strongly felt that those phone calls are against our Constitution Article 19. Before organising this meeting MASUM officially informed BDO Dinhata II about this camp / meeting and invited him to be present.

Mr. Edwin Lepcha, Secretary of Cooch Behar DLSA and his colleagues heard their stories passionately and assured that his department will take necessary steps to solve the problems.
